Greetings! Summer is in full swing here at the Visitor Center - after the cool, snowy weather of May, June is promising to be a great month. In this photo, you see Tour Guide Amanda Jones leading one of our five daily tours, starting out on the Observation Deck. Tours occur daily and start at 10am, then run every 90 minutes: 10:00am, 11:30am, 1:00pm, 2:30pm, and 4:00pm. Cost is \$8 for adults, \$7 for ages 55+, military, and students, and \$25 for a family (up to 6 people). We are also proud to be a Blue Star Museum, which allows active duty military members (and their immediate families) to ride the trolley FREE. Our one hour tour includes information on the Homestake Gold Mine, historic Lead, and the Sanford Underground Research Facility. This year, our trolley has slightly varied its route, traveling up Summit Street and giving riders an unparalleled view of Grand Avenue and Terry Peak. Our trolley is allowed through the gate at SURF; visitors in private vehicles will politely be asked to turn around. Once on the SURF property, trolley riders will be asked to don a hard hat as they enter the Yates Hoist Room. There is limited walking and only about six steps up into the Hoist Room. Our trolley tours and tour guides have received rave reviews on social media and you will leave knowing what neutrinos are and why we are so interested in these tiny particles! Please bring your Black Hills company in for a tour any time.



July will bring in our two biggest events of the summer: The 4th of July and Neutrino Day on July 13.
